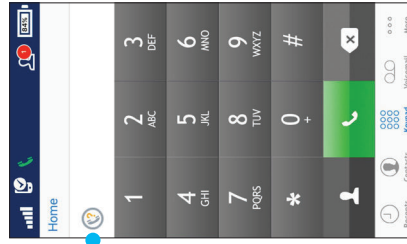


Making a call

1. Ensure Iridium Go is on & registered to the Iridium Network
2. Launch the Iridium Go Application, login & press the Call Icon
3. For the first time/call press 'Select Country' Icon & choose 'No Number'

How to make a call

To make a call within Australia

To call a fixed line in Melbourne (include area code) Dial 03 XXXX XXXX

To call a mobile in Australia Dial 04 XXXX XXXX

To call a Telstra Satellite phone Dial 0147 XXX XXXX

To make a call from outside Australia

To call a fixed line in Melbourne Dial 0011 61 3 XXXX XXXX

To call a mobile in Australia Dial 0011 61 4 XXXX XXXX

To call another country Dial 0011 - country code - number

Contacts

Your Iridium Go allows you to use your contacts in your smartphone on the Home screen, click Contacts and scroll through your contacts and select the desired contact, then the desired number. The Iridium Go will start the call.

Receiving Calls

The Iridium Go device loudspeaker will ring.

All users connected to the application will be alerted of the incoming call, the first user to answer will accept the call.

andy Tips

If you have any difficulty re-connecting to the Iridium Go restart both phone Iridium Go The Iridium Go must be used outside away from trees tall building unless using external antenna Try to place the Iridium Go at least 1cm above the ground or on a clear flat surface use grey plastic protective cover for long term use in direct sunlight or adverse conditions

LED status indicators

● Solid red	Powering on

our Iridium Go will arrive with a protective key-protective cover. The device can be used with or without the cover. To remove the cover, please ensure the cover is returned to it as directed by the device instructions.

WARNING - If your mobile phone or tablet is out of charge you will have NO access to the Iridium Go or satellite service



Getting Started and Connected

1. Iridium Go application must be downloaded on your device to access Service
2. Install Iridium Go Application on your mobile or tablet whilst connected to either your Wi-Fi network or mobile network coverage
3. Download application search for 'Iridium GO' via App Store for your Apple device or via Play Store for your Android device. Follow the prompts to install app

Pair your Iridium Go to your smartphone or tablet

1. Ensure Iridium Go is switched on & the antenna is raised
2. Go to Wi-Fi settings on your smartphone or tablet
3. Ensure Wi-Fi is turned on & search for nearby devices
4. Select the Iridium Go, displayed as Iridium-XXXXXX
5. Once your device has connected, you can begin using the application

Set-up & use your Iridium Go Application

1. Open Iridium Go application, press Login button located on the Home Page
2. Enter user name and password

 Password guest

NOTE: up to 5 users can simultaneously use tracking, SMS or Twitter at the same time, however **only one** user can make a voice call at a time.

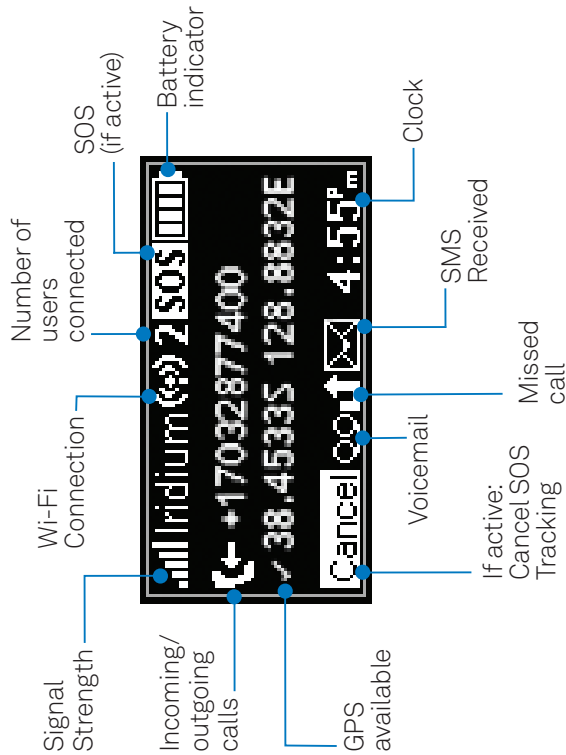
Using the SOS facility

SOS Application - This is preset to initiate a voice call to 000, it will also send out an emergency text message with GPS location to 3 programmed mobile numbers if this has been pre-organised with Satellite Hire Australia.
SOS Device Button - This will **ONLY** send out an emergency text message with GPS location if this has been pre-organised with Satellite Hire Australia.
WARNING - It does not allow voice connection

To Send an Text Message

Press the Message Icon from main screen
 Enter recipient mobile number ie +61 400 123 456
 You **MUST** have +61 & drop leading zero
 Enter message and press send

OT on Telstra mobiles may have difficulty in sending text messages to the satellite phone



Flick up the swivel antenna to the upright position. Your device will then automatically complete power up within one minute.



Important: The swivel antenna needs to remain upright during use. For best results place the device outside and orient towards the sky.
